

# Nash's Numbers by Alan Nash (Apple 95)

This month's article is only for drivers wishing to be 21<sup>st</sup> Century drivers and accept the Euro. 12 European countries now only use this new common currency. Travellers arriving at Eurostar, Heathrow, LCA and Paddington may well have Euros. If you wish to accept the Euro, cut out and stick the notice below on the dividing glass panel. You will find it a cheaper way of obtaining your holiday spending money.

At the time of writing the table below, Jan 2002, the exchange rate was 1.62. Check the exchange rate frequently as printed in the newspapers under "The Pound", but **do not use the tourist rate**. The table has been constructed to reflect the buy back rate and you will get at least the amount stated when taken in to exchange the money back to sterling. In general Thomas Cook offices do not charge commission to Licensed Cab drivers.
